(3) Purposes and legal basis of processing

Your data will be processed to fulfill the purposes listed below based on the indicated legal basis:

No.	Purpose of processing	Legal basis of processing
1	Organization and implementation of the event	Your data will be processed on the basis of Art. 6(1)(b) and (f) DSGVO
2	On-site event documentation/ BSIO public relations	Your data will be processed on the basis of Art. 6(1)(a) DSGVO.

(4) Data categories:

In order to fulfill the above purposes, we process the following data categories:

(5) Transfer of personal data to a third country

There are no plans to transfer your personal data to a third country.

(6) Duration of storage of personal data or criteria for determining this duration

Your basis data will be stored for 4 weeks from the day of the event and then deleted. Photographs will be taken for the purposes of BSIO's public relations work and will be stored for an indefinite period of time for a specific purpose, subject to revocation by the data subject(s).

(7) Rights of the data subjects, revocation notices, right to complain to a supervisory authority, and how to contact us

Reference to data subject rights

Right to revoke your consent, Art. 7 DSGVO.

If you have consented to processing by the BSIO by making a corresponding declaration, you may revoke your consent at any time for the future without any disadvantages. The lawfulness of the processing carried out until then remains unaffected.

Right to information, Art. 15 DSGVO.,

You have the right to information about the personal data stored concerning you.

Right to rectification, Art. 16 DSGVO.

If you discover that inaccurate data concerning you is being processed, you may request rectification. Incomplete data must be completed, taking into account the purpose of the processing.

Right to erasure, Art. 17 DSGVO.

You have the right to request the deletion of your data if certain grounds for deletion exist. In particular, this is the case if they are no longer necessary for the purpose for which they were originally collected or processed.

Right to restriction of processing, Art. 18 DSGVO.

You have the right to restrict the processing of your data. This means that your data will not be deleted, but will be marked to restrict its further processing or use.

Data portability, Art. 20 DSGVO.

Personal data provided by you may be made available to you in a commonly used structured format, if technically feasible.

Right to object to the processing of data, Art. 21 DSGVO.

If we process your data on the basis of a legal grounds, you have the right to object.

Right to complain to a supervisory authority about data protection violations.

You have the right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority if you are of the opinion that the processing of your data is not permitted under data protection law.
